- 5. In the event of a candidate failing the test a new nomination form must be submitted together with a further fee of R200.00 per module

	2.	Such horse riding activities will include but not be limited to riding, working with horses on foot, generally being on the premises for the purpose of taking instruction or any other activity undertaken by participants in riding lesson

Acknowledge that any vehicle / property brought onto the premises is solely at my risk and The Yard will not be liable for any damage that may be caused to such vehicle / property as a result of any of the staff, horses or ponies while on the premises. I further acknowledge that animals may have reason to be in the same area as vehicles while on the property and that such action shall not be deemed to be negligent by The Yard is so far as I have been warned of such a situation
