Syllabus

- 1 Know the letters of a 20 x 40 Dressage Arena
- Learn a rhyme to remember the letters: All King Edwards Horses Can Manage Big Fences or A Fat Black Moggy Cat Had Eight Kittens

Teaching Ideas and Resources

- Print out large letters for the children to look at, explain that the letters are where a movement starts or finishes.
 Look at all the letters in the arena.
- Place the letters in the right order on a table. Make this into a game and time the children. Use the top of a shoe box to represent a dressage arena and fill in all the markers. In an arena stand each child by a letter and shout the letter, or the word of the rhyme.
