Syllabus

- 1 Put a head collar on a pony.
- 2 Tie a quick release knot.
- 3 Know what to wear when leading and handling a pony.
- 4 Show how to lead a pony on the correct side in an enclosed area.

Teaching Ideas and Resources

- 1 Without the pony, practice undoing and doing up the head collar buckle. Rolling up the lead rope to leave tidy.
- 2 Practise quick release knots with ropes not attached to a pony. Explain why a pony should be tied to baler twine.
- **3** Dress up in what you should and should not wear when handling a pony.
- 4 Children leading each other up the yard and turning correctly.

- 2 Show how to tie a quick release knot to a piece of baler twine.

Answers

- 1 Head collar put on with member standing on the left-hand side and by pony's neck. Pony's ears comfortably through the headcollar.
- 2 A correctly tied knot that can be undone easily.
- **3** Answer to include boots with a heel, gloves, a hat, and clothes that are tucked in and zipped up.
- 4 Pony walked up and turned away from the leader. Leader to wear boots, gloves and a hat.
